

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING

1. About the Course

Karnataka Institute of Endocrinology and research, Bangalore has introduced the Post MD/DNB Fellowship in Diabetology, a one year Clinical Fellowship programme affiliated to the RGUHS. The course will enable physicians to brush up on the basics of diabetes, learn all aspects of holistic diabetes care and remain up to date with the latest advance in Diabetology.

During the course the candidates will be trained in different aspects of the holistic care of diabetes. They will also be exposed to the management of various diabetes complications through postings in the podiatry, vitreoretinal, paediatric departments. They will also have the opportunity to obtain a flavour of research in diabetes. At the end of the Course the candidate will be fully competent to deal with any type of diabetes patient as well as with diabetes complications of any degree of severity.

2. Course Duration

The Post MD/DNB Fellowship in Diabetology is Eighteen months course.

3. Eligibility

A pass in MD in General Medicine (from any recognized University in India) or a DNB in General Medicine (awarded by National Board of Examination, New Delhi).

4. Age Limit: 40 years

5. Course fees:

One time course fee of Rs.40,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) is payable at the time of admission by Demand Draft (cheque for local payment) drawn in favour of KIER, payable at Bangalore. Course fee includes Admission fee, Tuition fee, Examination fees, and other administration expenses. The course fee paid by the candidate following selection and admission is not refundable on any account, even in the event of discontinuation from the course at any part. After selection, the candidate shall have to execute a contract with the institution, committing not to discontinue, at any point of time of the course due to any reason.

8. Photo copies of the original certificates and other testimonials should be submitted along with the application form. The originals of the same set must be produced for verification at the time of interview.

If selected, the original certificates including Degree Certificates and Medical Registration Certificate * must be submitted to the Institution returnable only after completion of the Course.

* Candidates registered outside Karnataka State should be re-register with Karnataka Medical Council

9. Number of Seats : TWO

10. Mode of Selection :

An expert committee constituted by the institution called as selection committee will assess the aptitude and knowledge of the candidates. Committee's decision will be based on the performance of the candidates in the personal interview along with other credentials. The committee's decision on selection of candidates will be final. Any canvassing in this regard will be treated as a disqualification. Selected candidates will be individually notified. Candidate who fails to appear on the prescribed date for interview will not be considered for selection.

11. STIPEND

Selected candidates will be paid a monthly stipend of 40000/ month for the entire period of course duration. (No stipend for government in service and sponsored candidates)

12. RULES & REGULATIONS

At the time of admission the candidate should deposit all the Original certificates with the institution, which will be returned only after completion of the course. An Agreement / contract will have to be signed by the selected candidates.

During the 18 months course period, the candidate will be called "Fellowship Trainee. - The 'Fellowship Trainee' will be assessed at the end of each Semester and will be allowed to continue the training, only if the trainee's progress is found to be satisfactory. At the end of the eighteen month course, candidate will have to take up a written, oral and clinical examinations.

Unauthorized or unintimated leave will call for disciplinary action. Long absence or leave taken beyond the stipulated days will be referred to the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences for final decision.

Smoking inside the premises is strictly prohibited. Dress code as per Uniform Rules of the Institution must be adhered to strictly. Male Doctors should wear full arm white over coat during duty hours. Lady Doctors should wear saree/ Chudidhars and full arm white over coat.

A library caution deposit of Rs.2000/- (REFUNDABLE) is to be paid at the time of admission which shall be refunded at the time of leaving the Institution. Library books must be maintained in good condition, if not, due fine will be charged in proportion to the damage. The Management reserves the right to change the terms and conditions for admission, course content, fee charged, other regulations etc. during the duration of the course and also to post the Fellows to any institutions during the course.

Note: The course is affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Health Sciences and it is not recognised by MCI.
